### A Level Year 13

All students follow a 2 year IGCSE programme.

#### **Compulsory:**

English / Mathematics / Global Perspectives / PE and health.

Students select 6 additional subjects.

AS Courses are 1 year. Students will take 4 or 5 subjects.

English is compulsory.

<u>Prerequisites:</u> Subjects marked with \* require an IGCSE C grade or higher in order to study at AS level.

Students who successfully complete an AS course may continue that subject to a full A level.

A Combination of AS & A level subjects is possible in Year 13. Choosing 4 or 5 subjects.

Students are able to re-sit AS subjects if they wish to.
