

Music Brass Bursary Application

The Brass Instrument Bursary has been created to encourage students to learn a brass instrument and be involved in our Pinehurst co-curricular music groups.

This bursary entitles a student to have half their lesson fees paid for by the school when taking lessons for a brass instrument, through the itinerant music lesson programme at Pinehurst School. Bursaries will be given for a maximum of two years, after which time we envisage students will have received a good foundation in brass tuition and be prepared to fund their lessons in full.

The bursary is available to all students who commit to contributing to a Pinehurst co-curricular music group such as the Orchestra or Jazz Band. They must attend all rehearsals and represent our school at competitions and performances.

The bursary recipient is expected to regularly attend their brass instrumental lessons at a school and practise consistently, in order to advance their performance skills on the instrument. They will be expected to participate actively in the musical life of Pinehurst School and be a positive role model for their peers.
