INSTRUMENT  
AT PINEHURST

Everyone enjoys music, whether pop, rock, classical or jazz, and it is so much more rewarding if you can play an instrument yourself. Many adults wish they had learned a musical instrument while at school. Now is the opportunity for your child not to miss out!

Pinehurst offers every student, from Year 1 to Year 13 the opportunity to learn a musical instrument through our Itinerant Music Programme.



## HOW TO APPLY

To apply for a Music Itinerant Lesson, please log in to PINEnet and under 'Sports & Arts' select 'Music'. Click on 'Instrumental Lessons' and scroll down and click on 'Lesson Application Form please click here'. Fill in this form and click 'submit'. Once your enrolment has been approved, you will be contacted by the itinerant teacher or our Musical Director Ms Naumovska, who will notify you of your lesson time.

## WHAT IS THE COST?

Itinerant music lesson rates are \$32 for each half hour lesson (plus GST where applicable). The itinerant tutors will contact you to arrange payment.

## EXPECTATIONS

Students will:

- be prepared to become active participants in Pinehurst music groups
- show commitment by regular daily practise
- persevere, knowing that skills take a while to develop
- keep up to date with class work

## HOW DOES THE SCHEME OPERATE

Your son/daughter will be allocated a 30-minute time slot during the school day, or possibly just before or after school. This time will change each term (normally by one hour) so that he/she is not missing the same class.

In some cases privately arranged lessons outside of school hours can be arranged individually with our itinerant music teachers.

## HIRE OF INSTRUMENTS

Various music stores offer hiring options at reasonable rates. Both KBB and Music Works in Albany offer competitive rates. We advise that you speak to the itinerant teacher before purchasing a musical instrument for your child.

## WILL MY CHILD'S EDUCATION BE AFFECTED?

Yes – positively! Most students who learn a musical instrument develop greater concentration, self-discipline, academic success and increased social skills.

So long as the student is prepared to catch up on missed class work, it should be an enhancing experience. They gain more than they miss.

(open to any student who can play an orchestral instrument/voice at higher level)
