

Music Brass Bursary 2020 Application Form

This Brass Instrument Bursary entitles a student to a yearly contribution of \$400 towards their fees in learning to play a Brass Instrument while at Pinehurst School. The bursary is available to domestic and international students who are able to commit to contributing to a co-curricular music group at Pinehurst School, such as the Orchestra or the Jazz Band and must maintain an 85% rehearsal attendance and represent Pinehurst School at competitions and performances.

The bursary recipient is expected to have regular brass instrumental lessons at the school and needs to ensure they practice regularly in order to advance their performance skills on the instrument.

Bursary recipients will be expected to participate actively in the musical life of Pinehurst School and be a positive role model for their peers.
