Pinehurst teams are required to make the following commitment:

- Players are expected to represent the team and the school in the correct manner at all times
- To attend all team practices and games; this must be a priority over the season. This includes during Mid-year and Mock examinations. Other commitments are to be organised around trainings and games
- If a player cannot make a practice through injury/illness or family circumstances, then they must ring the coach / manager and not pass messages through other players

It is important to note when registrations close, Pinehurst School then commits the players to the event/sport and therefore has to honour these fees.
