A very very quick one from me this afternoon: as Auckland will be at Level 1 from midnight tonight, Pinehurst School will be back to its Level 1 arrangements from tomorrow morning.

This means that:

- All school classes, sports activities and events will go ahead as normal and with no restrictions
- Timetables in College will revert to their original rooms
- Masks may be worn by students and adults, but they are not mandatory
- We are still asking anyone who has just returned from Managed Isolation to spend one week
 at home before returning to school. This means that students whose parents have just
 returned from MIQ and who have come into the house will have to stay home unless they
 have been isolated from their parents
- We ask all visitors and parents to sign in with the Covid app when you come onto our site:
 this is the same as before, and something I do whenever I go into a cafe, shop or business

A final word. It's ten years since the Christchurch earthquake, and I'd like to take the opportunity to remember it. Most of us will recall where they were on February 22nd, 2011, and I'm sure all of us will want to send our best wishes to those affected by it. To those members of our community who were in Christchurch at the time, or whose families were affected, our thoughts are with you.
