If we are unable to field a Pinehurst Girls team in 2022, we will endeavour to place any girls interested in playing College Basketball in a composite team or in a Pinehurst team entered in a Boys League.

Please note – (as at the time of this letter being published) NH Basketball require all players **to hold a current vaccine pass.**

- Fees:** \$267.50 per player
Includes team registration, uniform hire, weekly coaching, NHBA and glory league fees.
- Uniform:** Pinehurst School Basketball singlet (all teams), Basketball Shorts (Top Teams only) or PE shorts and sports shoes or Basketball boots
- Coach, Manager & Score Bench:** Some teams may require a parent coach or manager.
Teams are also required to provide a scorer for each game.
Please advise on the registration form if you may be able to assist in any capacity. At the time of this letter being published, all adults coaching / managing / scoring must hold a current vaccine pass, and all spectators (where permitted) over the age of 12 years, 3 months must also provide a vaccine pass.
- Coach:** A coach will take weekly skills-based training sessions with our basketball students at Pinehurst School. Where possible, the coach will also attend the team's games.
- Commitment:** Students are expected to attend all trainings and games in both Term 2 & early Term 3 and be punctual for these activities.

If students are unable to attend due to illness, injury or other unavoidable circumstances, the team manager must be informed as early as is possible to enable them to make alternative arrangements if required for trainings or games.
- Transport:** Transport to and from games is the responsibility of the student or parent/caregiver for this after school activity.
