If a player cannot make a practice through injury/illness or family circumstance then they must

ring the coach / manager as soon as possible, not pass messages through other players

Please register online through the Pinehurst School website <u>Sports Registration | Pinehurst School</u> **Entries close Thursday 31 March**.
