If we are unable to field a Pinehurst Girls team in 2025, we will endeavour to place any girls interested in playing College Basketball in a composite team or in a Pinehurst team entered in a Boys League where appropriate.

Born 2008 or later - 16 years of age all year cannot be turning 17 during the year

Under 19's
Born 2005 or later - 18 - 19 years of age all year cannot be turning 20 during the year

Practices will commence Week 9, Term 1 and will run until the week prior to final games (no practices school / statutory holidays). There will be games and practices in week 3 of July holiday.

- Fees:** \$320 all players
Includes team registration, uniform hire, weekly coaching, NHBA and glory league fees.
- Uniform:** Pinehurst School Basketball singlet (all teams), Basketball Shorts (Top Teams only) or PE shorts and sports shoes or Basketball boots
- Coach, Manager & Score Bench:** Some teams may require a parent manager
Teams are also required to provide a scorer for each game
Please advise on the registration form if you may be able to assist in any capacity
- Coach:** Professional coach will take weekly skills-based training sessions with our basketball students at Pinehurst School. Where possible, the coach will also attend the teams' games.
- Commitment:** Students are expected to attend all trainings and games in both Term 2 & early Term 3 and be punctual for these activities
If students are unable to attend due to illness, injury or other unavoidable circumstances, the team manager must be informed as early as is possible to enable them to make alternative arrangements if required for trainings or games
- Transport:** Transport to and from games is the responsibility of the student or parent/caregiver for this after school activity
- Registration:** **Registrations open Thursday 20th February, 12pm**
