<b>Equipment:</b>	Students must bring their own racket (Please email Mrs Reid if your child does not have their own racket, we do have some spare rackets available).  Students need to wear their PE gear and suitable sneakers. Students need to bring a rain jacket to every session as the training will continue in light rain.
<b>Registration:</b>	<b>Open – from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025.</b> <b>Limited spaces are available.</b> <b>Registrations will close when the programme reaches capacity, or no later than 12pm, Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> April.</b>
