

## Basketball Years 7-8 (Semester 2, 2025)

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Registrations for Basketball are now open for the Year 7 & 8 Intermediate Basketball League for Semester 2 (Terms 3 & 4). We warmly welcome players new to the sport, as well as those who have experience playing Basketball.

Please note that you **do need to register your child for Semester 2**, even if they played in Semester 1. They will not automatically be registered for Semester 2.

**Trial:** **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June, 7:20am – 8:30am**  
Pinehurst Gym (wear PE gear & suitable shoes or basketball boots)  
Trials are held for all Year 7-8 students. All trials are compulsory for all students.

\*Parents are prohibited from attending trials

**Game Day:** Monday

**Game Times:** Vary, 4:00pm – 9:00pm, based on a weekly draw

**Season Dates:** Games commence Monday 28<sup>th</sup> July (Week 2, Term 3)  
Semester 2 runs for 13 weeks (across Term 3 & 4), which includes 4 weeks of grading and 2 weeks of play offs/finals.

**Game duration:** 2 x 12-minute halves, running clock and rolling subs

**Practice Day:** Friday

**Practice Time:** 7:20am – 8:30am

Trainings Commence: **Fri 25<sup>th</sup> July, Term 3**

**Uniform:** Pinehurst School basketball singlet (hired – included in fees)  
Pinehurst PE shorts  
Footwear - Sports shoes or basketball boots  
Mouthguard (compulsory)

**Manager / Scoring:** Some teams may require a parent manager.  
Teams are also required to provide a scorer for each game.  
Please advise on the registration form if you may be able to assist in either capacity.

**Transport:** Transport to and from games is the responsibility of the parent/caregiver for this after school activity.

**Commitment:** Students are expected to attend all trainings and games in both Term 3 & 4 (Semester 2) and be punctual for these activities.

If students are unable to attend due to illness, injury or other unavoidable circumstances, the team manager must be informed as early as is possible to enable them to make alternative arrangements if required for trainings or games.

**Cost:** \$260 per player *(includes league fees, membership fees, glory league, singlet hire, all professional coaching for Semester 2 (Term 3 & 4))*

**Registration:** Registrations open Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> June, 12pm.

Registrations close Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 12pm.
